

- Choice B: Use AI selectively and force you to think for yourself. Even if this prevents you from learning to work with the AI tools that will be part of your everyday work life.







Future Classroom: What if robots could teach your class? They're loaded with all the knowledge and can give you a hand, just like in a sci-fi movie.


- Choice A: Transform teachers into helpers rather than the main show, making every learning adventure personalized. Even if you miss out on the human touch and fun stories only teachers can tell.
